



- Weather...


Project 6 Relocate Twy B/Remove Twy A/ North Apron




Project 6

- Design is underway
- ▶ 65% design delivered to Staff and FAA December 17, 2014

Project 6 Phasing



Project 6 - Displaced Threshold



- Small aircraft only
- ▶ Cost for markings only: <u>+</u>\$40,000
- Useable for 17 days, max.

Project 6 - Displaced Threshold


Total Closure	25 days
Displaced Markings/Elec.	(1-2 days)
Removal of Markings	(2 days)
Runway Rehab/Repaint	(5 days)
Time Available	16-17 days

Project 6 - Displaced Threshold



- Over 15,000 CY of excess cut
- ▶ If disposed of off site:
 - ∘ \$120,000+ in additional project costs
 - 750 additional truck trips

Project 6 Phasing



Project 6

- Proceeding with design
 - Civil design/drawings
 - Incorporate hangar demolition
 - Incorporate runway rehabilitation
- Coordinating with FAA on funding


Project 6

Approximate Schedule:

 95% design (Staff/FAA review): 	Jan 23
 Plans available 	Feb 9
 Open bids 	March 3
 Start construction 	Mid-April
 Construction complete 	June 30

Additional Projects

- Hangar demolition
- Snow Removal Equipment acquisition

- ▶ Terminal tenant remodel/build out

- Acquisitions complete
- Facility removal will be added to Project 6
 - Scope of Work addendum to be presented in February

Snow Removal Equipment Acquisition (W.O. 14-08)




Snow Removal Equipment Acquisition

- "Piggy-back" on Idaho Falls acquisition
 - Idaho Code allows for this
 - No separate bidding process

Snow Removal Equipment Acquisition

- Scope of work for T-O services related to the purchase and delivery
 - Fee: Not-to-exceed \$12,447.00
- Board Actions Requested
 - Authorize chair to sign Work Order 14-08 with a not-to-exceed amount of \$12,447.00
 - Authorize staff to move forward with the acquisition process

 - Terminal


Parking Lot Improvements

- Funded locally
 - No AIP
 - No PFCs
- ▶ Total budget: \$625,000

Parking Lot Improvements

- Scope of work for T-O services to design and assist with bidding and construction
 - Fee: Not-to-exceed \$58,420.00
- Board Action Requested
 - Authorize chair to execute Work Order 14-09 with a not-to-exceed amount of \$58,420.00, subject to Staff and Legal Counsel review

Runway Rehabilitation

- Crack Seal/Seal Coat
- ▶ Repaint

Runway Rehabilitation


- PFC funded
- ▶ Total budget: \$200,000
- Will be incorporated into Project 6 as a separate bid schedule

Runway Rehabilitation

- Scope of work for T-O services to design and oversee bidding and construction
 - Fee: Not-to-exceed \$24,655.00
- Board Action Requested
 - Authorize chair to execute Work Order 14-10 with a not-to-exceed amount of \$24,655.00, subject to Staff and Legal Counsel review

Additional Terminal Remodel and Tenant Build Out

- Non-eligible work
- Developing scope of work and fee

SUN Approach Improvements Phase 2 Update


- ▶ DAC site visit Dec. 4 and 5 2014
 - Provide invaluable insight regarding terrain and environment around SUN
- DAC access to flight simulator time and actual flight
 - Thank you John Strauss
- Unique knowledge gained during site visit being used in procedure analysis
- February 2015 (tentative) for draft report and designs

Master Plan Update

- The Preliminary Master Plan activity forecasts will be submitted to the FAA Helena Airport District Office (ADO) in early January
- The Consultant Team will initiate work on the next step of the Master Plan, Facility Requirements, in January
- The Consultant Team tentatively plans to submit a second round of working papers in late February
 - Finalized Forecasts
 - Draft Facility Requirements
 - Initial Discussion of Future SUN Development Alternatives

Independent Board Member Selection Process

- Staff has received four resumes of individuals interested in the Independent Board member position
- All materials have been submitted to the Selection Committee and all FMAA Board Members
- The Selection Committee anticipates a Special Board meeting during the month of January, 2015
