- AIP '041 grant needed to complete the project

- ▶ AIP '041 grant affects this project, as well


Project 6 Relocate Twy B/Remove Twy A/ North Apron

 - AGIS as-constructed survey


Project 7

- Delivery scheduled for late 2015




Terminal Parking Lot Improvements

▶ Bid opening scheduled for April 15, 2015




Runway Rehabilitation

SUN Approach Improvements - Ph. 2

- March 16, 2015 Formal procedure amendment request to FAA
 - For RNP and RNAV–W
 - Based on FAA's recommendation
 - Need to get into FAA production cycle ASAP
- FPO has started preliminary procedure design
 - DAC analysis the basis of request/amendment for the RNAV-W

SUN Approach Improvements - Ph. 2

- ▶ Rick and T-O met with FAA FPO at FAA NW MTN Region Conference last week
- RNP may be NA'd due to "precipitous terrain" in missed approach
 - Using a beta terrain model to see if can be mitigated
- Amended RNAV W looks promising
 - \circ Maybe a +/- 40 ft. increase to DAC 6600' MDA for terrain
 - Still a +/-360 ft. improvement

SUN Approach Improvements - Ph. 2

- Current publication date July 2016
 - Rick going to see if that can be moved forward
- Next steps
 - FPO will continue design of procedures
 - Environmental Analysis
 - Continued coordination with FAA



- None of the chapter revisions affect the forecast numbers presented during the December or March Board meetings
