






### Master Plan Schedule

- ▶ Chapter E, Sitting Evaluation for Replacement Airport
  - Included in April Board packet
  - Discussion, public hearing, ATCT will be scheduled for the May Board meeting
- Chapter F, Financial Feasibility Analysis
  - Draft version will be included n the May Board packet
  - Discussion, public hearing, and action will be scheduled for the June Board meeting




### Noise Monitoring/Modeling

- Discussion of Directing Staff to Gather Information Related to Noise Monitoring/Modeling
  - Presented by:
    - Airport Manager

- No formal noise study has been completed in some time
- Reference: 14 CFR Part 150, *Airport Noise Compatibility Planning* 
  - Describes the FAA process
  - Noise study models noise based on current and forecast traffic
- A Part 150 study may show that noise impacts from the airport have decreased since the last study
  - Fewer operations
  - Aircraft fleet is generally quieter

Additional technology exists to monitor noise

 Unless a Part 150 study identifies noise above a federally-established threshold, costs for monitoring would likely not be AIP eligible

- ▶ Board Guidance Requested:
  - Should Staff further research a noise study?
  - If so, should that include monitoring?

#### Note:

- FAA has expressed funding support for at least part of a study.
- A separate consultant selection would likely be required for this study.

### Air Quality Monitoring/Modeling

- Discussion of Directing Staff to Gather Information Related to Air Quality Monitoring/Modeling
  - Presented by:

### Air Quality Modeling/Monitoring

- No stand alone air quality study has been completed at the airport
- ▶ Reference: FAA *Air Quality Handbook* 
  - Describes FAA implementation of air quality requirements of National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)
  - Air quality is modeled, based on current and forecast traffic

### Air Quality Modeling/Monitoring


- ▶ FAA is willing to fund an air quality analysis
- Air monitoring may be possible, as well
  - Likely would not be FAA eligible

### Air Quality Monitoring/Modeling

- ▶ Board Guidance Requested:
  - Should Staff further research an air quality analysis?
  - If so, should that include monitoring?

#### Note:

 A separate consultant selection would likely be required for this study.
