Runway Pavement Maintenance

- ▶ Sept. 18–20
- Cancelled due to contractor scheduling
 - Weather was horrible...
- Rescheduled for spring 2018
- Expect 1 1.5 day full closure
 - Early June 2018
 - Coordination with Delta

- Award Status
- ▶ Bidding and Construction Services Work Order (T-O)



Apron/Parking Lot Award

- Grant offered was received on September 18, including \$900K in discretionary funds
- Grant offer has been accepted by City and County
- Notice of Award has been issued to Idaho Materials and Construction
- Construction is scheduled for Spring/Fall 2018
 - Details will be worked out with contractor
- Utility relocations are planned for Fall 2017

Work Order

- ▶ T-O Work Order 17-07 includes:
 - Design of North Exit alternative (Schedule D)
 - Bidding assistance
 - Construction administration/inspection
 - Closeout
 - Other related services
- Proposed Fee: \$382,443.20
 - Time and materials

Work Order

- ▶ An Independent Fee Estimate (IFE) was prepared by CH2M.
 - IFE Amount: \$391,480
 - ∘ T–O fee under IFE by \$9,036
- Work Order and negotiation has been coordinated with FAA
 - FAA concurs with award
 - Based on FMAA approval, Record of Negotiation and executed W.O. will be sent to FAA for approval

Environmental Assessment – Land Acquisition and Obstruction Removal

EA Update

- Environmental Assessment Draft
 - ✓ Chapters 1–3 (Background and Planning, Purpose and Need, Preferred Alternative)
 - √ TO Quality Check (QC) on EA chapters complete
- Resource Reports
 - ✓ All evaluations complete (09/29/17)
 - ✓ TO will QC reports prior to submission to SUN and FAA
 - ✓ Incorporating into Chapter 4 (Affected Environment and Environmental Consequences)

Natural Resource Evaluation

- No Endangered Species or Habitat Identified
 - No special needs for Yellow-billed Cuckoo
- Migratory birds and nests have been observed
 - Obstruction removal currently planned outside of nesting season

Biological Resource	Avoidance Buffer	Preconstruction Survey Information	Published Avoidance and Minimization Measures
Special-status Bird Species (e.g., Migratory Bird Treaty Act, red tailed hawk)	Minimum 50 feet	Nest survey to be conducted 14 days prior to ground disturbance or construction during nesting season (February 1 – September 15)	Yes

Historic Resource Evaluation

Airport Site

- No historic districts identified
- Freidman Memorial Airport site recorded with all buildings, per FAA guidance.
- No buildings or sites are recommended as National Register of Historic Places eligible (NRHP-eligible)

Ranch

- Farmstead may be NRHP-eligible
- House and trees 'contributing' to farmstead quality
- Sub-consultant coordinating with State Historic Preservation Office

Next Steps

 - Specialized Resources reports (technical)
 - <u>Initial</u> drafts to FAA after Staff review for <u>initial</u> FAA review and comment
 - Cultural Resources report to SHPO
- November
 - Submit staff/FAA reviewed draft to FMAA
 - Public meeting/public comment period (Late Nov.)
- December
 - FMAA and public comments incorporated in final EA
 - FMAA acceptance of draft EA if deemed appropriate
 - Final EA sent to FAA/FONSI
