

Airline Operating Agreement and Terminal Building Lease

- Active negotiations with the carriers for months
 - Lease/Finance Committee
 - Staff
 - Legal Counsel
 - Ricondo
- New agreement reflects market rates
 - In compliance with FAA Grant Assurance and Sponsor Obligations
- > 3 year term with two 1 year options
- Action:

Motion to approve Chairman to execute the lease based on final review and acceptance by legal counsel



Snow Removal Equipment Bids

- Bids for Snow Removal Equipment were opened on August 30
- Five bids were received

Bidder	Bid
J.A. Larue, Inc.	\$528,448
Kodiak America LLC	\$530,000/\$535,000*
Oshkosh Airport Products, LLC	\$545,213
M-B Companies, Inc.	\$567,382
Wasua Equipment Company, Inc.	\$601,798

*Bid from Kodiak included two copies of bid page, with different prices on each copy.

Snow Removal Equipment Bids

- LaRue submitted "Type III Waiver" documentation for Buy American requirements
 - Anticipate disapproval from FAA
- Kodiak bid is non-responsive/disqualified
 - Two prices submitted
- Oshkosh submitted "Type III Waiver" documentation
 - Anticipate FAA approval



Snow Removal Equipment Bids


- What's next?
- Wait on FAA LaRue and Oshkosh waiver decisions
- Award as appropriate
- Expect request for Special Meeting in Oct.
 - Need to get equipment ordered
 - \circ +/- 11 month lead time



Landscaping

- Apron/Parking Lot project included significant landscaping improvements
- These were not included in project bid, as they are ineligible
- Costs were included in overall project cost estimate
- A preliminary landscaping design was prepared for City of Hailey design review process





Landscaping – T.O. Work Order 19–01

• Action:

Request approval of Work Order 19–01 with T–O Engineers, for services related to design, bidding and construction administration of parking lot landscaping.

Fees for this Work Order will be billed on a time and materials basis, not to exceed \$11,545.

- Phase 2 work continues
 - Retaining wall is complete

 - Trench drain is complete
 - Preparing for concrete paving
 - Concrete paving begins 10/3/2018

EA Status

- Review of 4(f) memo is nearly complete
 - Waiting on FAA Northwest Mountain Region legal review
- Next Step: Memorandum of Agreement with SHPO
- Once this is complete, EA can be finalized quickly and the public process can move forward
