

Equipment Lease Resolutions

- Equipment
 - Multi-terrain loader
 - Front end loader
- Lease for both
 - \$9,560/annual multi-terrain

- \$38,900/annual front end
- Lease expense(s) included in FY19 Budget (\$50,000)
- Government leases require resolution signed by authorized government agency representative
- Action:

Motion to approve Chairman to sign equipment lease resolution - multiterrain loader

Motion to approve Chairman to sign equipment lease resolution - front end loader based on final review and approval by legal counsel

FMAA Amended Regulation 94-1

- 3rd and FINAL Reading
- Regulation posted on the airport's website and distributed to GTSP operators and airport commercial tenants
- Next?:

Snow Removal Equipment Bids

- Awaiting (still) FAA decision on buy American waiver decision
- Award as appropriate
- Expect request for Special Meeting in Nov.
 - Need to get equipment ordered
 - \circ +/- 11 month lead time



Tower and Airspace Planning RFQ

- Planning services related to tower replacement
- RFQ on the street 9/5
- October 10 submittal deadline
- Selection Committee review and scoring
- Committee recommends selection of Ricondo





T-O Work Order Amendment

- Background
 - Contractor exceeded Phase 1 construction limits by 29 days
 - Engineering services during construction extended, as well
 - Liquidated damages were assessed in the amount of \$72,500
- Limits of construction administration budget have been reached, so an amendment is necessary
- At FAA's direction, amendment written to match the amount of liquidated damages



T-O Work Order Amendment

Board Action Requested

 Request approval of amendment to Work Order 17– 07 with T–O Engineers, for additional construction administration services provided due to contractor's overrun of contract time. Fees for this amendment will be billed on a time and materials basis, in an amount not to exceed \$72,500.00.







Terminal Air Carrier Apron and Parking Lot Improvements




Apron/Parking Lot Status

- Phase 2 is complete!
- Only Phase 4 remains
 - Final markings
 - Will be completed in the spring









Apron/Parking Lot Status

Construction Budget

Original Contract Amount	\$3,060,726
Current Projected Costs	\$2,761,341
Difference	\$299,385

- Difference due to:
 - \$72,500 Liquidated Damages
 - Quantity underruns



ARFF Equipment Acquisition

- Preparation of this specification will begin later this year
- Plan to bid in early 2019



Landscaping

- Design is nearly complete
- Quotes will be solicited before the Dec. meeting
- Consider award in December
- Construction will take place in Spring
