- Field visit (biological resources)
 - September 28–30
- FAA coordination
- Next Steps:
 - Cultural resources coordination
 - Preliminary DRAFT EA End of Oct.

Terminal Area Plan

Initial efforts to date:

- Terminal area existing conditions analysis
- Enplanement/passenger profile

Next Steps:

- Existing conditions preliminary technical brief
 - End of October
- Capacity assessment/stakeholder coordination
 - Mid-October
- Capacity assessment preliminary technical brief
 - End of October
