

# Project 6 Relocate Twy B/Remove Twy A/ North Apron



## **Award Timeline**

- Opened bids on March 3
- Board voted to award to Knife River –
   Northwest that evening
- Recommendation of award was submitted to FAA on March 5
- FAA responded on March 6, not concurring with award

## Project 6 – FAA Response

From Table U-6 of AIP Handbook:

(6) Proposals Containing Ineligible and/or non-AIP Funded Work. Per FAA policy, sponsors must obtain written ADO concurrence before including ineligible and/or non-AIP funded work within the same contract (see Paragraph 3–42). Per FAA policy, the sponsor must award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder on the AIP-funded portion of the contract when the bid is separated by line items or bid schedules. The sponsor must award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder on the entire contract when the bid will be prorated for federal participation.

## Instructions to Bidders

#### From Article 22.04:

- c. It is the Owner's desire and intent to award all items of Schedules A and B and C for which adequate funding is available to the "Successful Bidder." The Contractor is forewarned that Budget Limitations may prevent the award of the project or require the deletion of items or portions of the work scope of a given Schedule.
- The "Successful Bidder" for the purpose of subsequent negotiations, if necessary, will be the responsive Bidder who submits the low bid for Schedules A and B and C for the work to be awarded; which is expected to be all items of Schedules A and B and C based on availability of funding. The Owner's order of priority is Schedule A, Schedule B, and Schedule C in the order shown on the Bid Form.


### Instructions to Bidders

#### From Article 22.04:

- It is the Owner's desire and intent to award all items of Schedules A and B and C for which The Bidder's attention is directed to Article 19: "Evaluation of Bids and Award of Contract" of these Instructions to Bidders for further discussion of evaluation of the Bid and to Article 21: "Signing of the Agreement".
- The Owner reserves the right to delete all or a portion of individual Schedule(s) for budget, weather, schedule or other circumstances and select those Schedules or portions thereof which the Owner, at his sole discretion determines to be to the benefit of the project.

## **Options**

- Reject all bids and re-bid
- 2. Delete Schedule C and award to Western Construction
