


Instrument Approach Improvements

 - · FAA bares the costs to develop and maintain
 - FAA PBN staff and budget issues
 - Timing uncertain
- Additional option
 - Hughes Aerospace
 - \$143,000 RNP
 - \$50,000 LPV
 - · Annual maintenance fee
 - · \$36,000

Parking Management - Contract

- Management Contract
 - Lease Format Current
 - Fixed rent / income, Revenue sharing, Limited control, Lack of upgrade improvements
 - Management Format Proposed (3 years w/2 I year options)
 - · Complete control over all aspects of operation
 - · All revenue in FMA's account daily
 - Quality of staff control
 - New revenue control equipment



Parking Management - Equipment

- Amano "Overture"
 - Reliability
 - Credit card payment security faster processing
 - Reduced wait time at exit
 - Terminal pay station
 - Non charge tickets can self exit
 - After hours revenue capture
 - Remote monitoring
 - Reduced cashier hours
 - Reliable data for smarter planning











Parking Management - Construction

- Reconfigured parking traffic path and layout
 - Entry from the north
 - Better traffic flow
 - 2 Exit lanes
 - Faster processing coupled with terminal pre-pay station
 - No charge tickets wont need to wait for cashier
 - Both capable of credit card payment and monthly permit card processing



Parking Management - Moving Forward

Customers First

- Parking Ambassador & Cashier
 - Assist customers
 - Manage terminal drive / issue violations
 - Manage taxi and shuttle vehicles
 - Assist customers with automation / new equipment
 - Reduce rental car overlap

- Parking Ambassador
 - Slowly integrate automation to reduce expenses


Terminal Air Carrier Apron and Parking Lot Improvements




Apron/Parking Lot Status

UPDATE 02/13/18

- T-O met with FAA in Helena 2/6/2018
 - Discuss overall project schedule and cultural resources issues including ranch house

 - Coordination of mitigation with FAA continues
 - Section 106 Evaluation-Historic Survey Report needs to be submitted to SHPO
