

- Four companies expressed interested
- Two bids received

Rosenbauer Minnesota, LLC, Wyoming, MN	\$692,271.00
Estimate	\$630,000.00

ARFF Equipment Award

- Oshkosh bid has been reviewed and appears to be complete
- An FAA discretionary grant is anticipated to cover this acquisition
- Recommend award to Oshkosh Airport Products, LLC, subject to legal and FAA review, in the amount of \$665,642.00.

- Staff and Finance/Lease Committee continue to refine the FY '20 Budget
- Staff and Finance/Lease Committee will be prepared to present the recommendation of the proposed FY '20 Budget and Rates & Charges in the July meeting
- Following the July meeting, staff will prepare the appropriate advertisements and public notifications to conduct a Public Hearing
 - Public Hearing Must be held on or before the 2nd Tuesday in August and Budget must be adopted on or before August 13th
 - Any budget revisions would need to be made prior to July 11th to meet publication requirements
