


SUN Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory Overview

Local Context

- Blaine County 2018 Inventory of Community Greenhouse Gas Emissions
- Total GHG emissions of 332,004 tons
- Transportation GHG (excluding Airport) 133,982 tons

Infrastructure

- ASHRAE Level 1 Energy Audit
- COVE Tool Evaluation
- Investigate Snow Melting/Removal Technologies
- Electrified Ground Power
- Pre-conditioned Air
- Battery LED/Solar Taxiway Lights
- Airport Renewable Energy and Backup Power







Potential Emission-Reduction Measures

Ground Operations/GSE

- Electric Airport Vehicles
- Battery Operated Tug & Ground Service Equipment (GSE)
- Battery Operated Ground Power Units (GPU)

Fuel Supply

- Sustainable Aviation Fuels
- 100 Low Lead Alternative Fuel
