



Applicant Guidelines for Selection of Independent Member of the Friedman Memorial Airport Authority

The Seventh, Independent Member of the FMAA shall:

- Demonstrate knowledge, experience or familiarity with the aviation industry, including airport or aviation business and/or operations management.
- Demonstrate business and/or finance skills and experience.
- Demonstrate significant financial experience or education in real estate/commercial development or in business operations.
- Have familiarity with concepts associated with project funding and project implementation.
- Be a team player.
- Commit to serving at least a (2) two-year term, if appointed.
- Commit to attend at least 90% of FMAA meetings in person.
- Be a full-time resident of Blaine County for the last five (5) years.
- With respect to airport relocation, understand the positions of both owners and the concepts behind the dual path forward.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the history of Friedman Memorial Airport and of the airport relocation process.
- Support policies protecting the health and safety of residents adjacent to and affected by Friedman Memorial Airport.

Appointment Procedures

- The request for applications and criteria for appointment shall be public.
- Applications to be submitted to FMAA via airport staff.
- An FMAA subcommittee will evaluate applications and select a minimum of three candidates for oral interviews. If three candidates are not available, then the subcommittee shall send whatever candidates are available to the Board for consideration.
- The six, sponsor-appointed FMAA members will conduct the oral interviews with prospective candidates publicly. Discussion prior to selection and appointment of the 7th member may be conducted in executive session, pursuant to IC § 74-206(1)(a). Staff will be allowed to participate in these steps.
- Selection of the 7th member must be approved by vote by the remaining members in accordance with the FMAA Joint Powers Agreement.



- Reappointment. The six, sponsor-appointed members of FMAA, shall determine whether to reappoint the sitting seventh member, or whether to open the position to other candidates for consideration.
- The seventh seat shall be opened to other candidates, according to the process outlined above, at least every other two-year term.
